



PENDAFORM WINS INNOVATION AWARD FOR ENVIRONMENTAL CONTAINMENT SOLUTION.

PendaForm, was recently recognized as the winner of the *New Product Innovation of the Year* — presented by the Columbia County, Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation and Manufacturer's Council — for its invention, SiteSaver®. The idea for SiteSaver came from a need for improved containment solutions on Oil and Gas drilling sites. The methods being used were outdated and, quite simply, did not work. They leaked, they would easily tear, and they were slippery for those working on site; all of which were concerning to the site owners.

Engineered and designed by the PendaForm Engineering staff, SiteSaver is made from HDPE sheets, and is seamed together by an electro-fusion process for a leak-proof system. It is corrosion proof, impermeable to hazardous Fluids, and protects the ground beneath a site from becoming contaminated. A one-acre SiteSaver pad can be installed in a single day.

To qualify for the Product Innovation Award, PendaForm had to meet stringent criteria: advances in pollution control, recycling, and green programs. The introduction of SiteSaver, which is made from recycled materials and is also recyclable, showcases PendaForm's contribution to protecting and improving communities and the environment.

Winning the award also qualifies PendaForm for the 2013 Manufacturer of the Year Award (MOTY) where PendaForm is one of six nominees for the large company category. The state awards will take place at the end of February in Milwaukee.
